

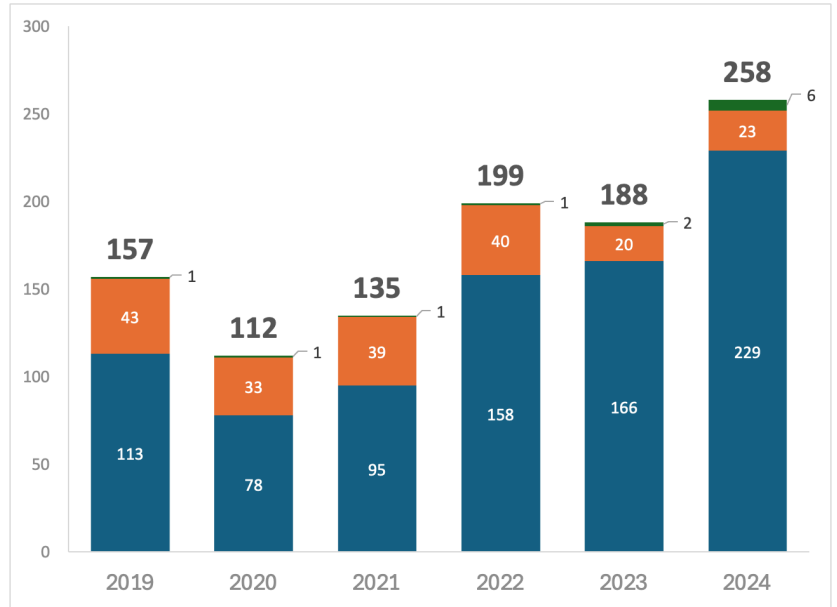
HOUSING & HOMELESS COALITION OF CNY CAYUGA COUNTY 2024 PIT



From 2023 to 2024 homelessness in Cayuga County increased by **37%** and has increased by **64%** since 2019.

Homeless Population by Project Type 2019 - 2024 PIT Counts

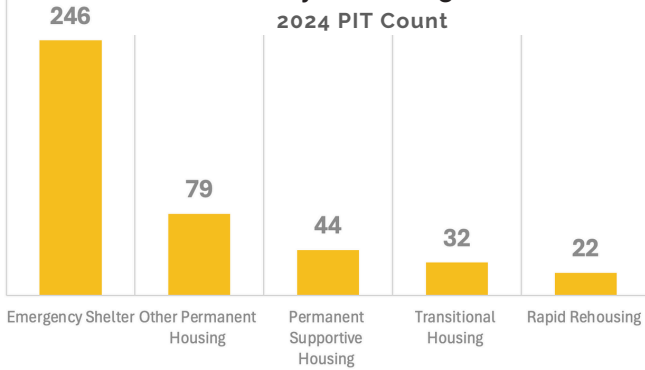
● Emergency Shelter ● Transitional Housing ● Unsheltered

IN CAYUGA COUNTY:

- Homelessness has increased at **about the same rate** as the full Continuum of Care from 2019 to 2024 (Cayuga: 64%; CoC: 63%).
- Cayuga County accounts for approximately **22% of the homeless population** in the Continuum of Care, though the county only accounts for **11% of the total population** of the three-county region.
- **49%** of the people experiencing homelessness in Cayuga County are **families** with at least one child.
- Veterans and people experiencing chronic homelessness remain low.
